
COURSES

Youth Innovation and Entrepreneurship (Teen Start-up)

Focused on innovation and entrepreneurship, this course will be taught by multiple industry experts and CEOs, guiding students through the design thinking process to identify problems, define solutions, and create a startup business plan from scratch. The 3-week, CEO-led program fosters skill development in teamwork, innovation, creativity, communication, and sustainability.

Students will be able to:

- Apply the design thinking process to solve real-world problems
- Collaborate effectively in diverse teams to develop innovative ideas
- Create a business plan
- Pitch their startup to potential investors
- Public speaking - Build confidence and improve articulation
- Deliver speeches effectively
- Engage with an audience
- Overcome public speaking anxiety
- Study environmental science and sustainability
- Understand environmental issues
- Explore ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) practices
- Develop sustainability projects

This program is designed for 6th-grade students and above who have an interest in business and entrepreneurship.





Artificial Intelligence

The Coding and AI program introduces students to computer programming and artificial intelligence. Through hands-on projects, they will learn to code in languages like Python or JavaScript and explore AI concepts such as machine learning and neural networks. The course enhances problem-solving skills and logical thinking, enabling students to develop coding projects and basic AI applications while understanding AI's ethical implications.



Public Speaking and Debate

Through structured practice and constructive feedback, students will learn the fundamentals of effective communication, from crafting compelling speeches to engaging in rigorous debates.

Language Programs

Each course focuses on developing proficiency in reading, writing, listening, and speaking, ensuring a well-rounded language education tailored to each student's needs.

Level Assessment: At the start of the program, students' proficiency levels are assessed using the IXL learning system, which provides a detailed analysis of their strengths and areas for improvement. This ensures that every student is placed in the most suitable course to maximize their progress.

- Beginners will build foundational skills, including reading, writing, and speaking. Our pure English environment would help beginner-level students to develop daily communication skill.
- Intermediate-level students focus on building fluency and strengthening their grammar, vocabulary, and comprehension skills through ESL system's personalized practice modules.
